#### **Claim information:**

Claimants believe George Joseph Arsenith (DOB 6/17/1949) may have been exposed to asbestos cement pipe in Truckee, California, before dying of mesothelioma on January 11, 2025. Mesothelioma is a fatal and incurable cancer caused only by exposure to asbestos. Exposure to all types of asbestos increases an individual's risk of developing mesothelioma and there is no safe level of exposure to asbestos for the disease mesothelioma. Mr. Arsenith is survived by his widow, Christy Arsenith, and his two children, Merriann Cassidy and George Joseph Arsenith Jr.

The Town of Trucke's negligence, including but not limited to its negligent construction, supervision, hiring and specification of deadly asbestos-containing materials, including asbestos-containing transite pipe may have exposed Mr. Arsenith to asbestos through work he performed, work performed in close proximity to him, and work performed by his father George Macedo Arsenith Sr. (DOB 7/29/18). Further, Mr. Arsenith may have been exposed to asbestos as the result of unsafe conditions on the Town of Truckee's property.

This exposure includes but is not limited to construction projects while Mr. Arsenith or his father were employed by T & S Construction, McGuire & Hester, and Granite Construction from the 1950s to 2000s involving installation and/or removal of asbestos-containing water, sewage, or drain pipe, as well as work at water treatment facilities and/or pumping stations. This included, but was not limited to, construction projects detailed in the job list attached hereto as **Exhibit A.** 

As a result of his mesothelioma, Mr. Arsenith died prematurely and suffered immensely over the last weeks and months of his life, sustaining over \$100,000,000 in noneconomic damages. These damages include immense physical pain, mental suffering, loss of enjoyment of life, disfigurement, physical impairment, inconvenience, grief, anxiety, humiliation and emotional distress. Further, he sustained approximately \$5,000,000 in economic damages including, but not limited to lost household services, social security and retirement benefits and medical and funeral costs.

His wife Christy Arsenith also sustained significant loss of consortium damages for the loss of George's love, companionship, comfort, care, assistance, protection, affection, society, moral support and physical relations, totaling over \$50,000,000.

Finally, Mr. Arsenith's children, Merriann Cassidy and George Joseph "Joe" Arsenith Jr., have suffered losses due to the death of their father, totaling over \$25,000,000 each.


