**Subject:** Proposed Re-Zoning at West End Donner Lake

We are the owners of two parcels on Donner Pass Road, situated between Donner Lake Rd and South Shore Drive in the proposed NMU zoning area. These adjacent parcels are shaped as a flag type lot with a very narrow long lot and a shallow back lot. With this configuration we have limited street frontage on the front lot. The second parcel is only accessed by an existing driveway through the first parcel. Our question is whether there will be open options written into the NMU zoning for taking into account odd size parcels, as is known that all parcels have very different shapes and do not fit in a "standard' for the current potential percentages of commercial verses residential.

We had envisioned building out the second parcel with the possibility of providing several local housing units. It seems like this could be difficult to achieve this objective were the 50% commercial requirement applied to this virtually land-locked parcel and the front parcel bordering Donner Pass road is very narrow.

For these two particular parcels, a 10% commercial requirement could be met creatively to adhere to this possible requirement in the NMU zoning.

We would also like to point out that having owned property in the West End of Donner Lake for 20 years, we have seen very few successful commercial undertakings at that end of the lake. The isolated nature of the West End, with only one way in and out, severely limits the foot traffic that a commercial property would need to thrive. In addition it does seem most any commercial business would need to survive on 8 +- months of sales as the West End has very limited people in the off seasons.

For this reason we believe the NMU zoning in this area should reflect the greater need for sustainable affordable housing, coupled with improved shuttle service to get folks to town

Thank you for taking this into consideration while this moves forward in the process.
