

Date: Tuesday, November 14, 2023 Honorable Mayor and Council Members: Author and title: Cindy Peterson, Finance Manager Title: Authorize the Settlement and Payment Release of Damage Claim Approved By: Jen Callaway, Town Manager Recommended Action: That Council authorize the Town Manager to offer a settlement to CSAA Insurance Exchange (AAA) for \$12,310.18 for a damage claim filed against the Town. Discussion: On January 2, 2023, there was a collision between the claimant and a Town operated snow plow at the roundabout at Soaring Way and Joerger Drive. Police were called to the scene and after an investigation and statements received from both parties, the police report determined that the Town snow plow caused the accident due to unsafe backing. Becky Bucar, Acting Director of Public Works at the time of the accident and Jen Callaway, Town Manager have reviewed the claim information and have recommended that the Town approve this claim for payment. The claim was filed on behalf of the claimant through CSAA Insurance Exchange. Town Municipal Code Section 3.16.010.1 (d) requires that the Town Council recommend settlement or denial for claims of \$10,000 or more. Documentation related to this claim is in the risk management file and is available for your review. **Priority**: **Enhanced Communication** Climate and Greenhouse Gas Reduction Housing Core Service Infrastructure Investment Emergency and Wildfire Preparedness Fiscal Impact: The Town will offer \$12,310.18 in exchange for full and final settlement of the claim. This will come from the snow removal budget for fiscal year 2022/2023. Staff anticipate that there is sufficient budget to cover this expense.
