7.1 Measure V Renewal and Call for Election.

Recommended Action: That Council: (1) Adopt Resolution 2026-04 calling for the placement of a special sales tax on the June 2, 2026 Primary Election ballot; and (2) Introduce Ordinance 2026-01 establishing a one-half percent transactions and use tax for the renewal of Measure V.

Alfred Knotts, Assistant Public Works Director, presented from the staff report (presentation on file with Town Clerk).

Council Discussion:

- Approval to place this tax measure on the ballot will not raise taxes; if approved by Truckee voters, it will maintain the current rate and extend the collection without a sunset date.

7.2 Donner Lake Pilot Transportation Strategy Update and Buffered Bike Lane Implementation Standards.

Recommended Action: That Council: (1) Receive an update on the implementation of recommended pilot transportation strategies along Donner Pass Road adjacent to Donner Lake; and (2) Accept the Buffered Bike Lane Implementation Standards.

Blake Kloczl, Engineering Technician II, presented from the staff report (presentation on file with Town Clerk).

Council Discussion:

- Measure V renewal can help fund the maintenance of buffered bike lanes.
- Narrowing travel lanes allows the Town to reduce the speeds to 30 miles per hour or less and improve bike facilities through the addition of buffered bike lanes.
- By installing boulders in locations where parking is not permitted, drivers will be guided to designated parking areas.
- Additional traffic-related items will be included for discussion at the next workplan update.
