PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

This CIP includes six projects funded by the California Energy Commission's Local Government Building Decarbonization Challenge grant, which supports community and municipal building decarbonization planning. The grant-funded projects include developing an equitable funding strategy to implement measures in the Town's Existing Building Decarbonization Roadmap, development of an Energy Resilience Plan, planning for the electrification of Town facilities and fleet, development of building decarbonization policies or programs, and workforce training and education around building decarbonization measures.

REASON FOR OR BENEFITS OR PROJECT:

These grant-funded projects will support planning to reduce greenhouse gas emissions from building energy use in Truckee, support Town fleet electrification, and improve the resilience of the community to the impacts of climate change.

OPERATIONAL COST IMPACTS

This project is fully funded by \$700,000 in California Energy Commission grant funds to support the Town's building decarbonization planning initiatives, reducing the amount of Town funds necessary to support these efforts.
