**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TRUCKEE AUTHORIZING
THE TOWN MANAGER TO ACCEPT AND ENTER INTO A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE
CALIFORNIA ENERGY COMMISSION**

WHEREAS; the California Energy Commission offers a variety of funding opportunities to advance the state's transition to clean energy and transportation through innovation, efficiency, and the development and deployment of advanced technologies, including the Local Government Building Decarbonization Challenge grant; and

WHEREAS; the California Energy Commission requires the applicant's governing body to declare by resolution certain authorizations related to the administration of California Energy Commission grants; and

WHEREAS; the Town of Truckee has established goals to reduce greenhouse gas emissions, including from building energy use in new and existing buildings; and

WHEREAS; the Town Council of the Town of Truckee adopted a Climate Action Plan Element as part of the 2040 General Plan and a climate change adaptation plan, Climate Ready Truckee, outlining specific initiatives to reduce greenhouse gas emissions from building energy use and improve the resilience of the community to the impacts of climate change;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Council of the Town of Truckee authorizes the Town Manager, or their designee, to accept and enter into a grant agreement with the California Energy Commission for the Local Government Building Decarbonization Challenge Grant (GFO-23-403).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town Manager, or their designee, is hereby authorized and empowered to execute in the name of the Town of Truckee all documents related to this grant agreement with the California Energy Commission.
