Title: Resolution Authorizing Applications for CalRecycle Individual Grants

Recommended Action: Adopt Resolution 2023-65 Authorizing Submittal of Individual Grant Applications for All Grant Programs for Which the Town of Truckee is Eligible.

Discussion: The California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) administers various grant programs to support the State's efforts to reduce waste generation through source reduction, recycling, and reuse programs at the local level. These programs include the SB 1383 Local Assistance Grant, which provides funding to local jurisdictions to assist in implementing the requirements established by Senate Bill 1383 to reduce methane emissions from landfilled organic waste.

For all grant programs, CalRecycle requires applicants to submit a resolution from their governing body authorizing submittal of an application and execution of all grant documents and identifying the Signature Authority for the jurisdiction. The maximum duration of the authorizing resolution is five years from the date of adoption. The Town's previous authorizing resolution, 2016-36, has expired. In order to be eligible for upcoming grant programs such as the current cycle of SB 1383 Local Assistance Grant funds, the Town would need to adopt a new authorizing resolution.

Fiscal Impact: Approval of this resolution would allow the Town to apply for up to \$75,000 in SB 1383 Local Assistance Grant funds for FY 23-24, as well as any future CalRecycle individual grant programs offered during the grant term.
