RESOLUTION 2026-22

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TRUCKEE ADOPTING THE
SB 1 ROAD MAINTENANCE AND REHABILITATION ACCOUNT PROJECT LIST FOR
FISCAL YEAR 2026/27**

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and Signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and

WHEREAS, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the residents of the Town of Truckee (Town) are aware of the projects proposed for funding in the community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the Town must adopt by resolution a list of all projects proposed to receive year funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB 1, which must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and

WHEREAS, the Town will receive an estimated \$474,975 in RMRA funding in Fiscal Year 2026-2027 from SB 1; and

WHEREAS, this is the tenth year in which the Town is receiving SB 1 funding and will enable the Town to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation projects, safety improvements, repairing and replacing aging bridges, and increasing access and mobility options for the traveling public that would not have otherwise been possible without SB 1; and

WHEREAS, the Town posted the intention to use the RMRA funds for the 2027 Paving and Drainage Project on the Town's website on May 19, 2026, to solicit public input; and

WHEREAS, the 2027 Paving and Drainage Project includes paving approximately 9.2 miles of roadway throughout the Town of Truckee: and

WHEREAS, the Town used a Pavement Management System and Budget Process to develop the SB 1 project list to ensure revenues are being used on the most high-priority and cost-effective projects that also meet the community's priorities for transportation investment; and

WHEREAS, the funding from SB 1 will help the Town improve safety, expand active transportation infrastructure, and maintain and rehabilitate 9.2 miles of road in the Town this year and similar projects into the future; and

WHEREAS, the 2023 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs Assessment found that the Town's streets and roads are in a "good" condition, and this revenue will help the Town maintain the overall quality of our road system; and

WHEREAS, the SB 1 project list and overall investment in the Town's local streets and roads infrastructure with a focus on basic maintenance and safety, investing in complete streets infrastructure, and using cutting-edge technology, materials and practices, will have significant positive co-benefit statewide;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED, AND ORDERED, BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TRUCKEE AS FOLLOWS:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
2. The following list of newly proposed projects will be funded in part with Fiscal Year 2026/27 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues as further described in Exhibit A.
3. Appoint the Town Manager, or designee, to execute all applications, negotiations and agreements, which may be necessary for completion of the aforementioned project and expenditure of RMRA funds, except those designated to the Town Engineer below.
4. Appoint the Town Engineer, or designee, to execute and submit all reports, payment requests, and changes to the project description, which may be necessary for completion of the aforementioned project and expenditure of RMRA funds.

PROPOSED PROJECT:

2027 PAVING AND DRAINAGE PROJECT (C2702)

Project Description

This annual paving project is consistent with the adopted Town of Truckee Pavement Maintenance Program (PMP). The purpose of the PMP is to evaluate the condition of paved Town roads, forecast the deterioration of those facilities, and develop a cost-effective method for maintaining acceptable roadway surfacing service levels Town wide. The SB1 funds are proposed to be used for the construction phase, which will include paving of approximately 9.2 miles of roadway within the Town of Truckee.

Project Location

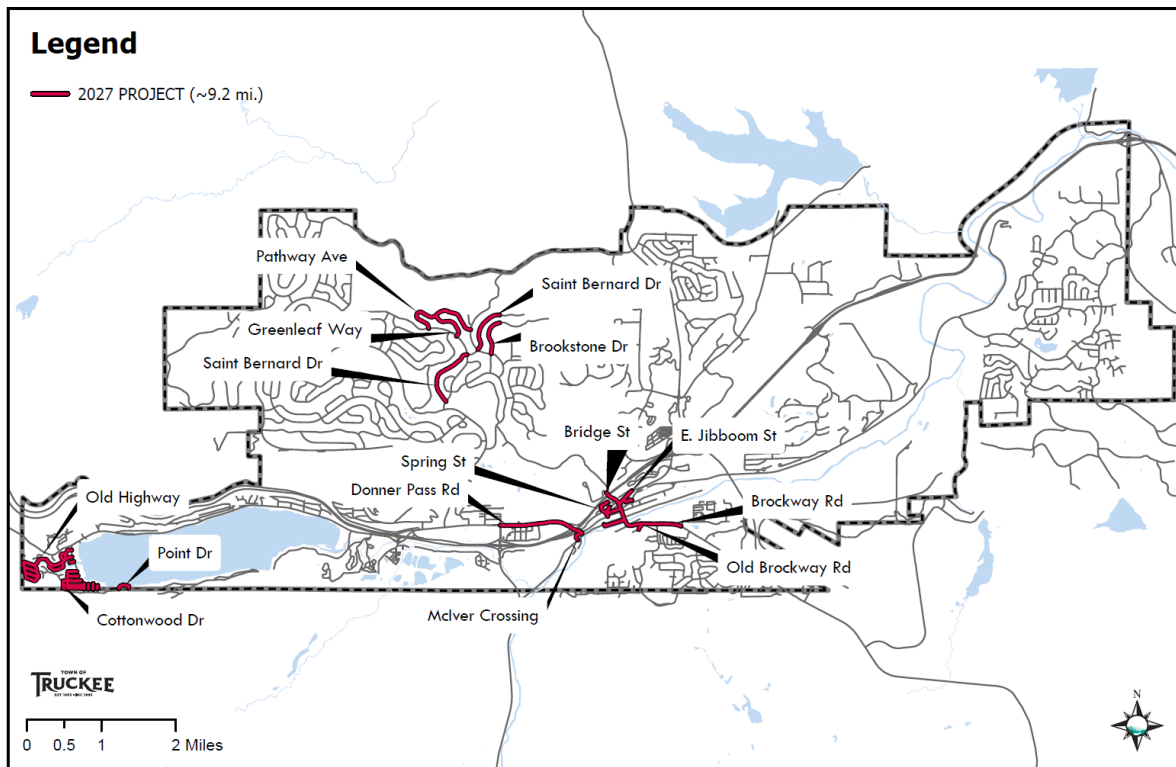


Figure 1: 2027 Paving and Drainage Project Map

Project includes paving approximately 9.2 miles of roadway within the Town of Truckee, including portions of Brockway Road, Donner Pass Road, Bridge Street, E. Jibboom Street, Spring Street, and roadways within the Tahoe Donner Subdivision and West End of Donner Lake neighborhood as depicted in Figure 1. The project scope may be modified depending on available funding for the project and updated roadway ratings.

Proposed Schedule for Completion

Construction is anticipated to begin in spring/summer 2027, with an anticipated project completion by November 2028.

Estimated Useful Life

The 2027 Town of Truckee Pavement Maintenance Program estimates that most roads require repaving every 8 to 25 years depending on their functional classification, use, and location (higher elevations and snow loads tend to cause roads to deteriorate at a faster pace). Estimated Useful Life of this paving work is 25 years.

Current Townwide Pavement Condition

Per the 2025 Pavement Maintenance Program, the average Pavement condition index on all Town Roads is 84.

Sustainability and Other Benefits

To the extent practical, pavement grindings will be reused for pavement base and shoulder backing. This Project includes pavement maintenance and rehabilitation which will improve bicycle and pedestrian safety and mobility.
