## A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TRUCKEE AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TO EXECUTE AGREEMENTS WITH THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TAX AND FEE ADMINISTRATION FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF A LOCAL TRANSACTIONS AND USE TAX

**WHEREAS**, on March 19, 1998, the Truckee Town Council approved Ordinance No. 2024.03 providing for a local transactions and use tax; and

WHEREAS, on December 4, 2008, the Truckee Town Council approved Ordinance No. 2008-12 amending the Truckee Municipal Code extending the termination date of the existing Transactions and Use Tax to December 31, 2028; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 12, 2024, the Truckee Town Council approved Ordinance No. 2024-03 imposing an additional Truckee Transactions and Use Tax; and

WHEREAS, the California Department of Tax and Fee Administration (Department) administers and collects the transactions and use taxes for all applicable jurisdictions within the state; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department will be responsible to administer and collect the transactions and use tax for the Town; and

**WHEREAS,** the Department requires that the Town enter into a "Preparatory Agreement" and an "Administration Agreement" prior to implementation of said taxes, and

**WHEREAS**, the Department requires that the Truckee Town Council authorize the agreements;
