CONSIDERATION OF <u>RESOLUTION NOS. 5908-25, 5909-25, 5910-25</u> ACCEPTING GRANT FUNDS FOR TRAFFIC SAFETY ENFORCEMENT THROUGH OREGON DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

The attached are resolutions to accept grant funds from Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) for the purpose of traffic safety enforcement in several areas.

- ODOT awarded the City of Tualatin \$12,000.00 in grant funds for Distracted Driving Enforcement;
- ODOT awarded the City of Tualatin \$20,000.00 in grant funds for Speed Enforcement;
- ODOT awarded the City of Tualatin, \$15,000.00 in grant funds for Vehicle Safety Restraint Enforcement;

The Police Department has partnered with the Oregon Department of Transportation for many years through grant funding to pay for additional enforcement efforts to keep the motoring public safe. ODOT provides programs to ensure that our community is riding safely on our roadways, teens understand the consequences of distracting driving, and the adults in their lives are given the tools to guide them.
