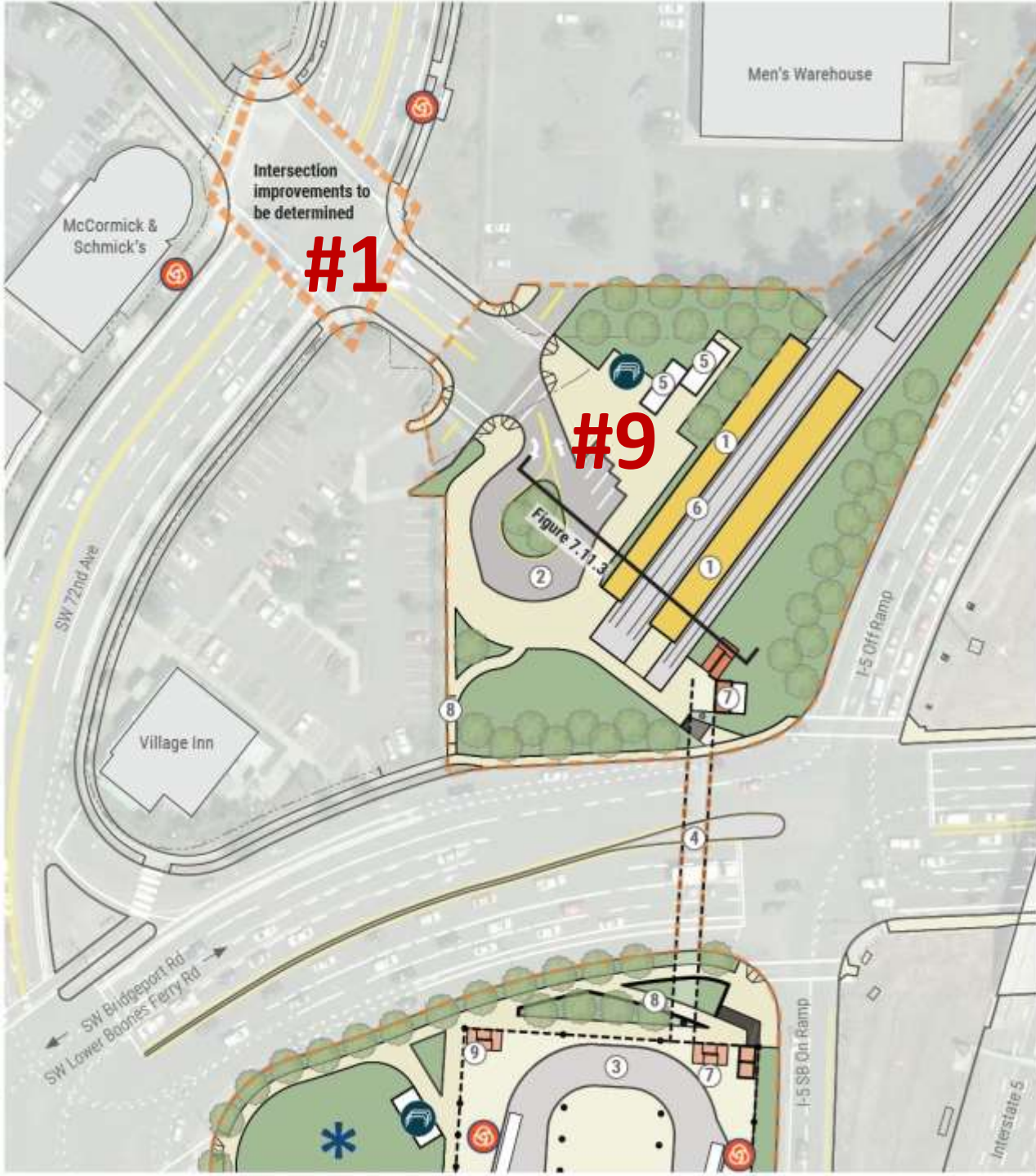

- Does not obligate Tualatin to fund any part of the light rail system

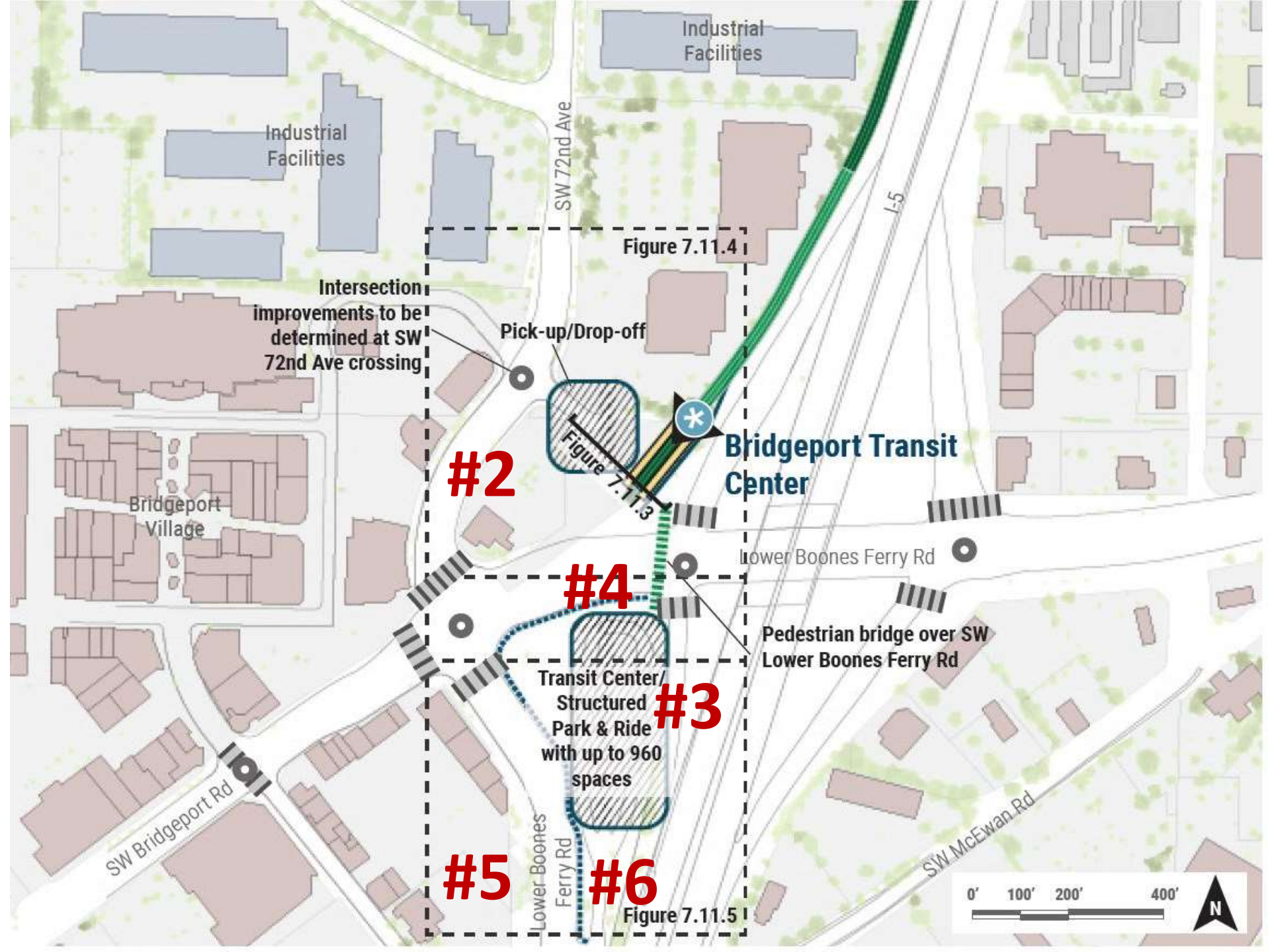


**STATION FEATURES**

- ① Split platforms
- ② Pick-up/drop-off
- ③ Transit Center/Structured Park & Ride with up to 960 spaces
- ④ Pedestrian bridge connecting station to Transit Center/Park & Ride
- ⑤ Potential systems building location
- ⑥ Tail track for additional train at end of line
- ⑦ Stair and elevator access to pedestrian bridge
- ⑧ Accessible ramp entries
- ⑨ Stairs to upper levels of structure

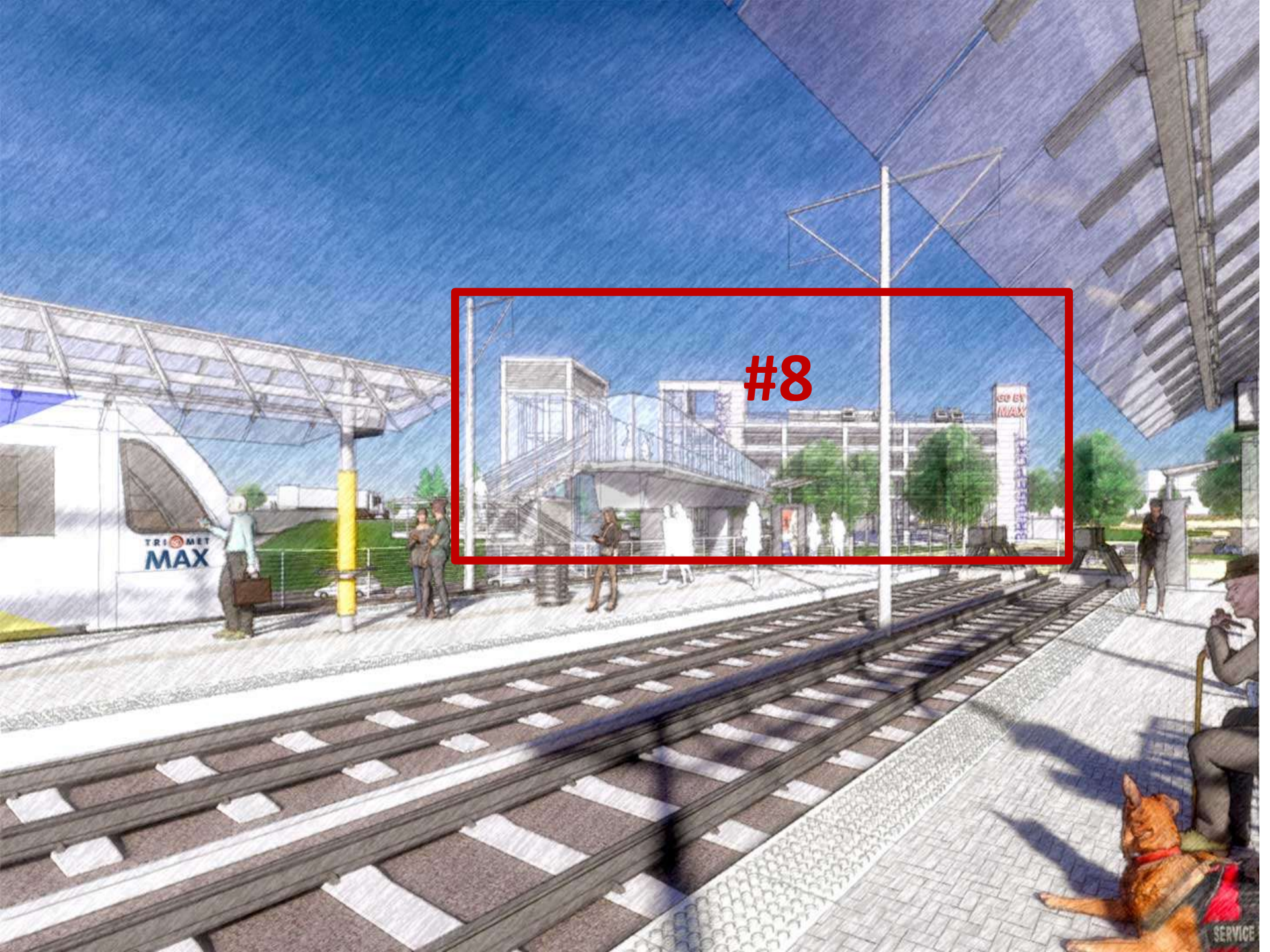
Figure 7.11.4

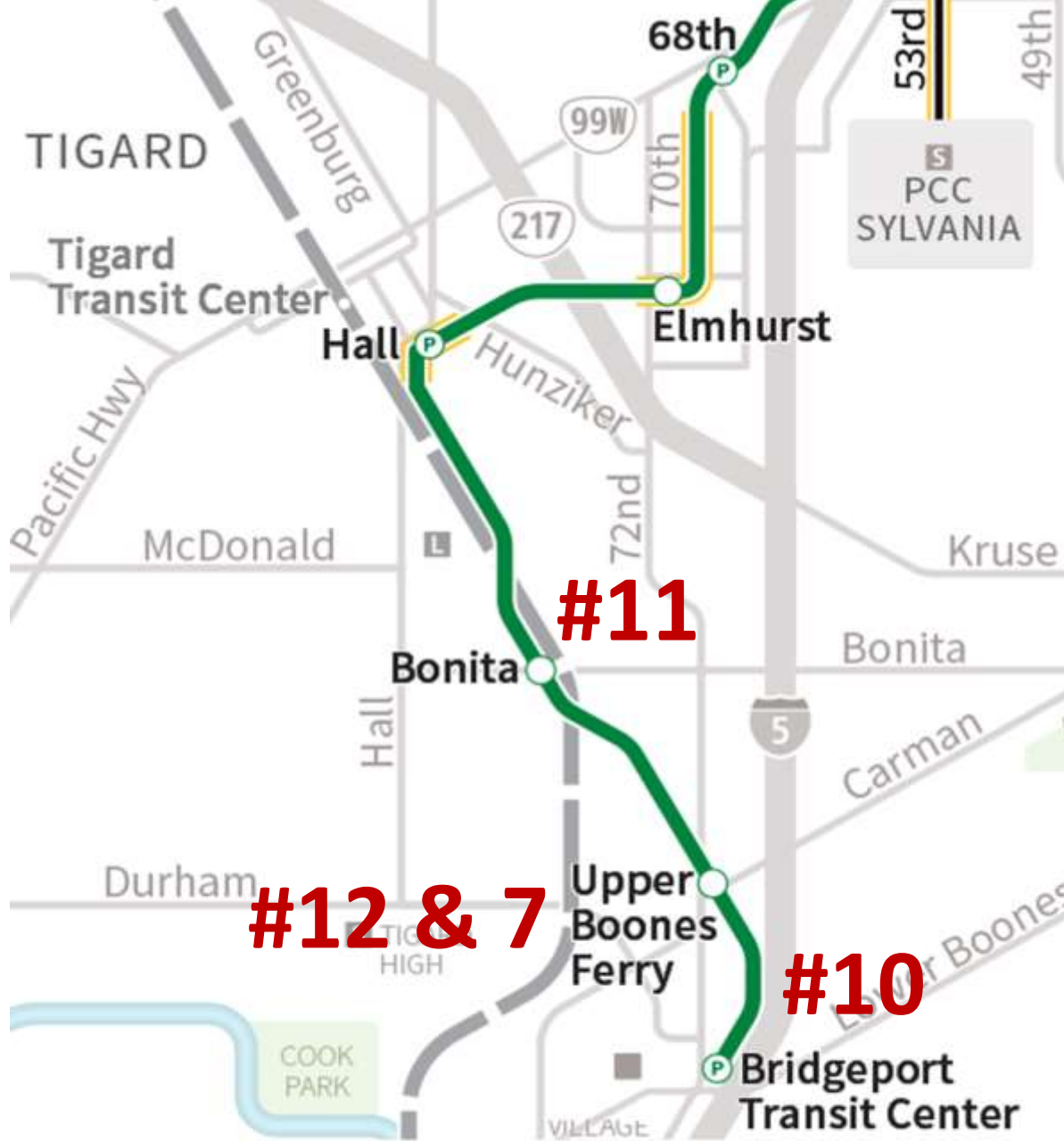
Figure 7.11.5
