Southwest Corridor Memorandum of Understanding and Letter of Support

RECOMMENDATION:

Provide staff direction on a draft Memorandum of Understanding and letter of support between Tualatin and TriMet on the Southwest Corridor Project.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The Southwest Corridor Project is an effort to establish a new 12-mile <u>TriMet MAX line</u> between southwest Portland and the future Bridgeport Transit Center in Tualatin (video). In addition to light rail, the plan includes roadway, bicycle and pedestrian projects, a strategy to promote equitable development in the corridor (<u>SWEDS</u>), and a shared investment strategy for transportation improvements that connect into the project.

Based on feedback received from City Council, staff has drafted a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) and letter of support. The letter will be helpful in increasing the federal competiveness of the funding application by showing local support. The MOU between TriMet and Tualatin will help clarify the issues of most importance as this project progresses into greater design.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

There are no financial obligations from the City of Tualatin that derive from this MOU or Letter of Support.
