## SUBJECT:

Consideration of <u>Resolution No. 5524-20</u> Authorizing the City Manager to Sign an Intergovernmental Agreement with the US Department of Justice and Department of the Treasury to Receive a Share of Forfeiture Proceeds.

## **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

The Tualatin Police Department on occasion assists in law enforcement efforts which result in federal forfeitures. Be signing the Federal Equitable Sharing Agreement, we will be eligible to request an equitable share of the net proceeds of the forfeitures.

The Federal Equitable Sharing Agreement, entered into with the US Department of Justice and Department of the Treasury, sets forth the requirements for participation in the federal Equitable Sharing Program and the restrictions upon the use of federally forfeited funds, property, and any interest earned thereon.
