

RESOLUTION NO. 5696-23

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE DEEDS ACQUIRING PROPERTY FOR THE BOONES FERRY CORRIDOR IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

WHEREAS, in May 2018, Tualatin voters approved a \$20 million bond measure to support high priority transportation projects.

WHEREAS, the City identified the need to improve the Boones Ferry Road corridor to include improved sidewalks, bike lanes, curb ramps, traffic signals, and improve access to existing transit stops (hereafter "Project").

WHEREAS, the City has identified the need to acquire certain properties in order to facilitate the construction of the Boones Ferry Corridor Improvement project; and

WHEREAS, the City has negotiated this property transaction with willing sellers to acquire right-of-way, public utility easements, and temporary construction easements.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TUALATIN, OREGON, that:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to acquire and execute deeds for the following property:

- A. Tax Lot 2S124CB02300 – Neff and Cronin Family Trust
 - Right-of-Way and Temporary Construction Easement for \$64,600

Section 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to acquire property and property interests identified in Section 1.

Section 3. This resolution is effective upon adoption.
