Parks Bond Project Update

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

City Council adopted the Parks and Recreation System Plan in 2019. This plan identified the need for parks, trails, recreation facilities, and river access. This planning processes involved extensive public outreach and community engagement. The Parks and Recreation System Plan demonstrated the need to preserve natural areas and provide active recreation to serve community members. Based on City Council Vision and Priorities, a Parks Funding Measure Committee was formed. The committee recommended a Parks Bond and priority projects to include in a voter initiative. Council placed the Parks Bond measure on the November 2022 ballot, which Tualatin voters approved.

Staff will present the status of the Parks Bond projects and project schedule.
