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**SUBJECT:**

Consideration of **Resolution No. 5695-23** Awarding the Contract for Construction of the Highway 99W: Pony Ridge Neighborhood to 124<sup>th</sup> Avenue project.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommends that Council approve the resolution awarding and allowing the City Manager to execute a contract with Brown Contracting, Inc. to construct the Hwy 99W: Pony Ridge Neighborhood to 124<sup>th</sup> Avenue project in the amount of \$663,223.

**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

This project would improve Highway 99W by constructing a pathway along the northwest side of the highway, connecting 124<sup>th</sup> Avenue to the Pony Ridge Neighborhood. Major items of work consist of approximately 1,400 lineal feet of pervious concrete walkway, driveway regrading, two ADA compliant curb ramps, storm culvert extensions, block retaining wall, bus stop improvements, and other items.

The construction contract was advertised in the Daily Journal of Commerce on April 21, 2023 and the Business Tribune on April 21, 2023. Two bids were received before the bid period closed on May 9, 2023. Brown Contracting, Inc. submitted the lowest responsible bid for the project in the amount of \$663,223.

**OUTCOMES OF DECISION:**

Adopting the resolution and authorizing contract execution would allow construction of this project to proceed.

**FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS:**

Funds for this project are available in the Transportation Project Fund.
