# Project Overview



- Install up to 1,000 Level 2 electric vehicle charging ports in Tualatin and 16 neighboring Cities.
  - Partner Cities: Beaverton, Forest Grove, Gresham, Hillsboro, King City, Lake Oswego, McMinnville, Milwaukie, Newberg, Oregon City, Portland, Salem, Sherwood, Tigard, Woodburn, and Wood Village.
- Chargers will be located at multifamily housing and public facilities.
- Increase access for low- and moderate-income residents.
- Total project budget - \$18.8M
  - Federal grant award - \$15M
  - EV charging partner match - \$3.6M
  - PGE - \$200,000

- Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) adds project to the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP)
