A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A GRANT AGREEMENTWITH THE FEDERAL HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION ACCEPTING A \$15,000,000 CHARGING AND FUELING INFRASTRUCTURE AWARD

WHEREAS, the Charging and Fueling Infrastructure Discretionary Grant Program (CFI Program) is a competitive grant program created by the federal Bipartisan Infrastructure Law to strategically deploy publicly accessible electric vehicle charging and alternative fueling infrastructure in the places people live and work;

WHEREAS, on August 28[,] 2024, the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) awarded the City a \$15,000,000 grant award under the CFI Program to fund the Tualatin and Neighbors Charging Up (TANC-UP) project;

WHEREAS, the TANC-UP project will deploy up to 1,000 electric vehicle (EV) charging ports throughout Tualatin and 16 neighboring Cities in the Northern Willamette Valley, including Beaverton, Forest Grove, Gresham, Hillsboro, King City, Lake Oswego, McMinnville, Milwaukie, Newberg, Oregon City, Portland, Salem, Sherwood, Tigard, Woodburn, and Wood Village;

WHEREAS, the TANC-UP program will help avoid a regional "charging divide," aligns with the City's Climate Action Plan Strategy 6.1 (Fuel Switching) as well as two Council priorities (Environmental and Transportation) and provides the charging infrastructure necessary for low and moderate-income residents an opportunity to access electric vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the City must execute a Grant Agreement with the FHWA to fund the TANC-UP Project.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TUALATIN, OREGON, that:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to execute a Grant Agreement with the Federal Highway Administration accepting a \$15,000,000 Charging and Fueling Infrastructure (CFI) Award to fund the TANC-UP project.

Section 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute amendments to the Grant Agreement that are administrative in nature and necessary to receive funding for the TANC-UP project.

Section 3. This resolution is effective upon adoption.
