- Staff met with other Cities and internal departments to collect feedback about e-scooters
- Council directed staff to draft pilot
 Agreement Jan. 2022
- Staff worked with Bird to draft License Agreement language




PRINCIPLES




- I2-month pilot program
- Non-exclusive
- Start small; 50-75 scooters
- \$0.10 fee per ride to City
- Agreement can be canceled by either party
- Data sharing with City
