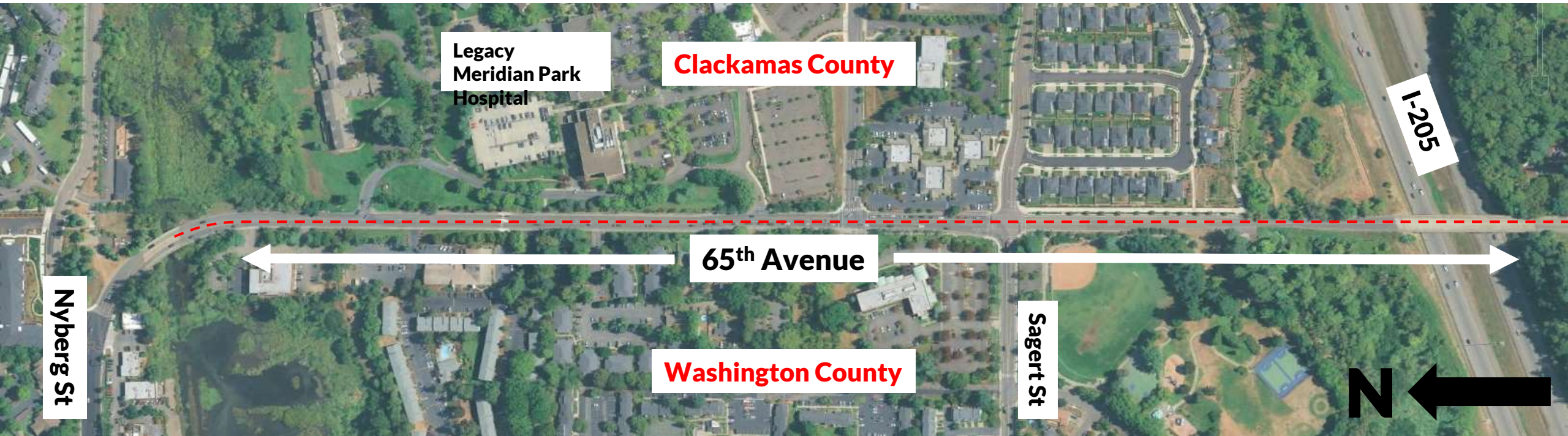

Existing Conditions



Transfer Details

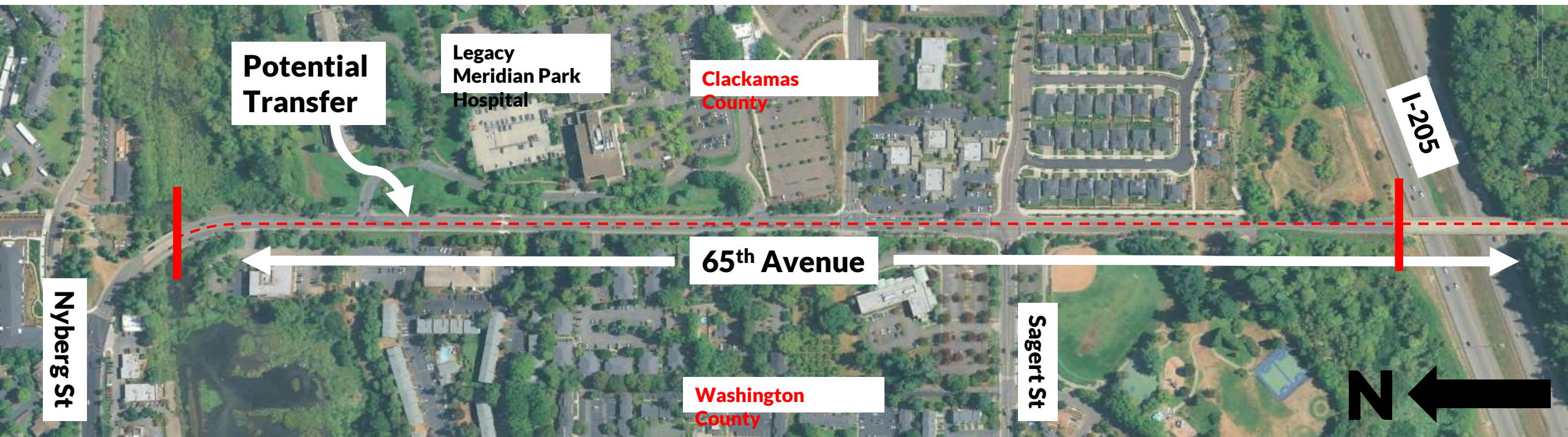


- \$750,000 in exchange for roadway
 - Must be used for 65th & Borland Improvement Project
- Transfer of 0.65 miles of 65th Ave
- Pavement Condition Index is 83 (Good)
- Existing IGA between Washington & Clackamas County has Washington County maintain 65th Ave
 - Neither County intends to adjust the IGA in the foreseeable future
- Washington County to continue to maintain 65th Ave
 - Washington County would not bill Tualatin
- Future maintenance costs are possible

Next Steps

- Next steps could include:
 - Clackamas County authorizing transfer
 - Tualatin City Council authorizing City Manager to enter into intergovernmental agreement with Clackamas County to accept transfer
 - City of Tualatin would own the eastern half of SW 65th Ave
- Otherwise, Clackamas County and Washington County would continue to split ownership of the roadway.
 - Capital projects would continue to require both Washington and Clackamas County approvals/permitting, including the 65th & Borland Improvements Project.
