Hear and consider complaints about Library policies or materials.

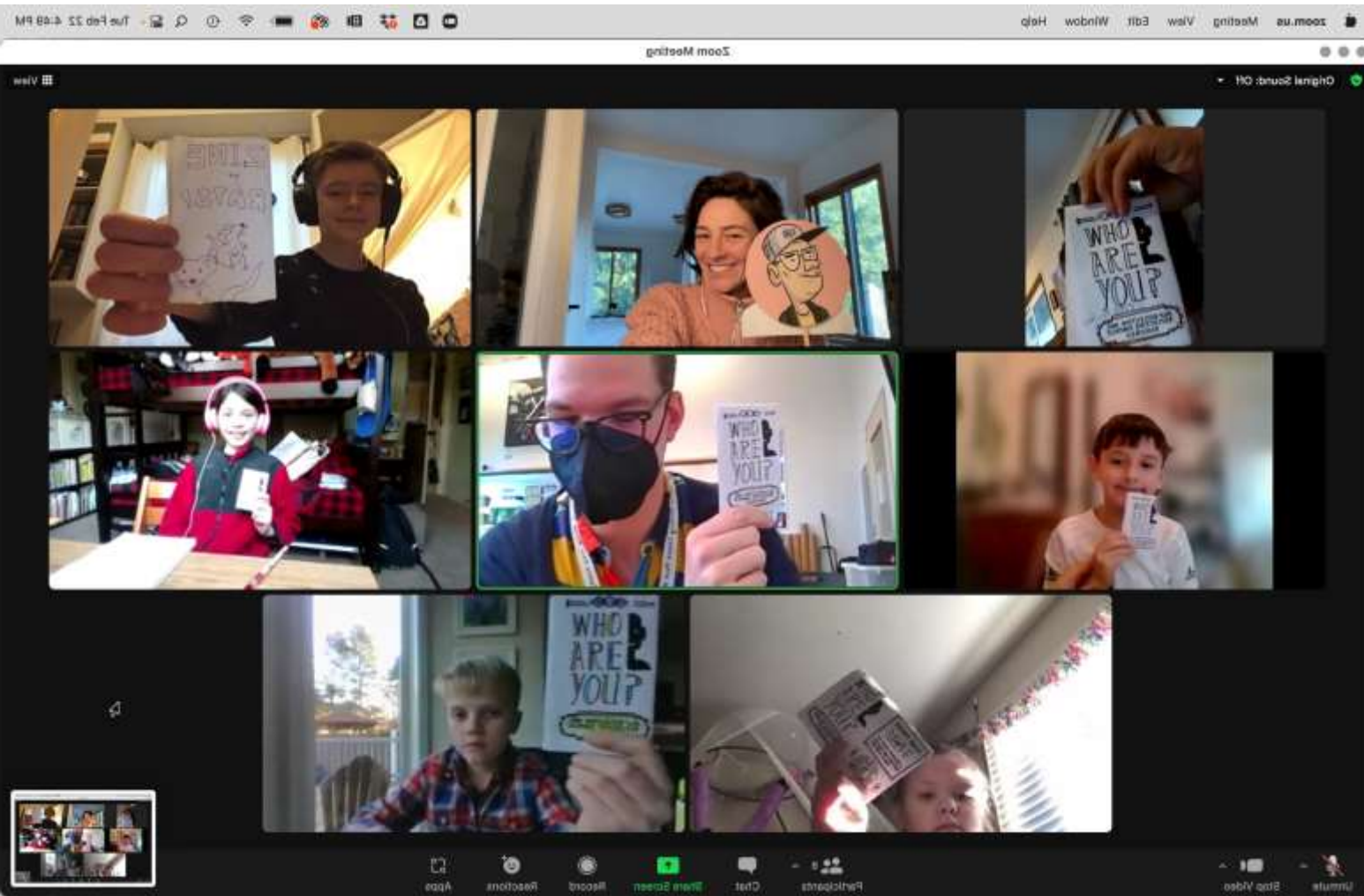


Consult on Matters Affecting Library Operational Policy
