SUBJECT:

Consideration of <u>Resolution No. 5716-23</u> Awarding the Contract for Construction of Boones Ferry Corridor Phase 2 Improvements, Part of the Tualatin Moving Forward Program.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that Council approve the resolution awarding and allowing the City Manager to execute a contract with Brown Contracting, Inc. to construct the Boones Ferry Corridor Phase 2 Sidewalk and Bike Lane Improvements in the amount of \$2,492,566.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

This project would improve Boones Ferry Road from Tualatin-Sherwood Road to Sagert Street and at its intersections with Avery Street, Ibach Street, and Iowa Street to improve conditions for pedestrians, cyclists, and drivers. Major items of work include roadway widening, pavement removal and replacement, curb and sidewalk improvements, ADA-compliant pedestrian curb ramps, pedestrian crossing beacons, traffic signal modifications, signing and striping, irrigation, landscaping, and fencing.

The construction contract was advertised in the Daily Journal of Commerce on May 22nd and 24th, 2023 and the Business Tribune on May 23rd and 26th, 2023. Three bids were received before the bid period closed on June 27, 2023. Brown Contracting, Inc. submitted the lowest responsible bid for the project in the amount of \$2,492,566.

OUTCOMES OF DECISION:

Adopting the resolution and authorizing contract execution would allow construction of this project to proceed.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS:

Funds for this project are available in the Transportation Fund.
