Proclamation Declaring the Week of May 10-15, 2021 as National Police Week in the City of Tualatin.

## **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

May 15 of each year has been dedicated by Congress as Police Memorial Day, and the week surrounding it is dedicated as National Police Week. On average, one law enforcement officer is killed in the line of duty somewhere in the United States every 54 hours. Since the first known line-or-duty death in 1791, more than 22,000 U.S. law enforcement officers have made the ultimate sacrifice. The City of Tualatin is proud of our law enforcement officers and wishes to recognize their commitment to the public safety profession.
