




Incident Sub-Categories


Structure Fire Types Residential Commercial

*Critical Patients: cardiac arrest, chest pain, stroke, seizure, breathing problem, drowning, respiratory distress, respiratory arrest, or trauma system entry. "MVC"=motor vehicle crash.









Data Filters: no test, information, interfacility transports, or mobile health care incidents.

Incident data gathered geospatially based on city boundary.
