### SUBJECT:

Consideration of **Resolution 5564-21** Rescinding the State of Emergency Related to COVID-19

### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

On March 23, 2020 the City Council adopted Resolution No. 5488-20 declaring a state of emergency related to COVID-19.
