Q1

- Actively engage in onboarding new Parks Director
- Support beginning utility fee facilities assessment
- Engage with City Finance staff to identify best practice for Parks Bond funding oversight role
- Evaluate existing tree codes for climate resiliency updates & recommendations

Q2

- Actively pursue implementation of Parks Bond projects
- Engage with City Planning staff to identify intersections between Parks and the Downtown Core planning process
- Better understand the Parks budget and the relationship between projects and programs
- Facilitate momentum around identification of field improvements in partnership with Youth Sports and TTSD
- Collaborate with the IDEA committee to coordinate overlap of activities
- Completion and appropriate community celebration of Veterans Plaza

Q3

- Construction of Nyberg Creek Wetlands Trail
- Continue discussion around updates to park naming policies to prioritize community inclusion
- Renew conversations about a Community Center
- Advise staff on action plans from facility assessment report
- Explore potential for an integrated pest management program

Q4

- Continue to support design and construction of ARPA-funded Las Casitas Park
- Assist staff with prioritizing Utility Fee projects
- Continue to support progress on new river access
