1) <u>Recommended Action</u>:

Adopt the proposed fee changes as outlined herein and authorize the Mayor to sign Resolution R2022-012.

2) <u>Background</u>:

The City annually adjust fees via fee resolution that applies to all City service areas. Staff presented proposed changes to the Public Works Committee on November 17, 2022. The Committee recommended moving the fee schedule resolution to the December 6, 2022 City Council Consent Calendar for adoption. Since that time, one fee was added in Table II for a MFTE application fee of \$100. This is a fee that the City has been charging, but was not on the previous fee schedules.

4) <u>Alternatives</u>:

Do not adopt the proposed fee changes.
