SUBJECT: Service Provider Agreement with Strategies 360 for Legislative Advocacy Services

1) Recommended Action:

Staff recommends the City Council approve and authorize the City Administrator to sign the proposed Service Provider Agreement with Strategies 360 for Legislative Advocacy Services.

2) <u>Background</u>:

The City annually adopts a Legislative Agenda to guide the City's policy and funding requests for the State Legislature. In the past, this has resulted in funding for trails and streets, support for the Shared Legislative Agenda, Brew Tower funding, support for the Craft Brewing and Distilling Center, and changes to annexation laws. Strategies 360 is highly regarded for their legislative services and is familiar with Tumwater, municipal issues, and the Legislature. This is a one-year contract.
