# 1) <u>Recommended Action</u>:

Staff recommends the City Council approve and authorize the City Administrator to sign the proposed Service Provider Agreement with the Thurston County Chamber of Commerce for Shared Legislative Agenda Partnership services.

### 2) <u>Background</u>:

The City annually adopts a Legislative Agenda to guide the City's policy and funding requests for the State Legislature. This agenda includes regional priorities developed by the Shared Legislative Agenda Partnership, which focuses on common interests to maintain the region's economic vitality and generate opportunities that enhance the quality of life for residents in the Thurston County Region. The Partnership includes the City of Olympia, the City of Tumwater, the City of Lacey, the City of Yelm, Thurston County, the Port of Olympia, the Thurston County Chamber of Commerce, and the Thurston Economic Development Council. The Thurston County Chamber coordinates the activities and deliverables of the Partnership.

- I-5 Improvements
- Homeless Response Funding
- Maker Space Expansion
- Climate Change Response
- Budd Inlet Restoration
