SUBJECT:	Resolution No. R2022-015, Charitable Partnerships

1) <u>Recommended Action</u>:

Adopt Resolution No. R2022-015 authorizing certain partnerships with charitable organizations and limited use of City resources.

2) <u>Background</u>:

The City frequently partners with organizations to host employee or community drives (such as a toy, food, or blood drive). Resolution No. R2022-015 identifies charitable organizations for employees to participate in, to a limited degree, for fundraising campaigns and donation drives at the City and allows the City to invite community participation. It also provides Council authorization to staff to utilize limited City resources to partner with these charitable organizations in the community that directly relate to a City service, facility, or community drive. Resolution No. R2022-015 is an update to Resolution No. R2020-021. The changes include updating the name to Bloodworks Northwest, adding Red Cross and Olympia Firefighters Foundation.
