



## Investigations

### Commercial Burglaries

**Two subjects removed wiring, brass fittings, and A/C parts resulting in hundreds of thousands of dollars damage.**

### Malicious Mischief

**Working with FBI on intentional damage caused to a power substation (in excess of \$100,000).**

### Financial Crimes

**Fraud, stolen credit cards, check washing.**

### Sexual Offenses

**Rape, child sexual abuse, child pornography.**

### Attempted ATM Theft

**Worked with ATF & FBI in arrest of two individuals who caused in excess of \$100,000 damage to credit union in attempt to remove ATM.**

### Abuse Referrals

**Child abuse, elder abuse, abuse of vulnerable adults.**






