SUBJECT:	Proposed Permanent Supportive Housing Project for Seniors

1) <u>Recommended Action</u>:

Letter of support for the project.

2) <u>Background</u>:

At the December 13, 2022 City Council Worksession, Council discussed allocation of the City's \$550,000 of ARPA housing funds. The desire was to assign \$275,000 to the Franz Anderson Permanent Supportive Housing project and reserve another \$275,000 for a potential hotel conversion in Tumwater. The Housing Authority of Thurston County has an agreement to purchase a hotel building on Capitol Boulevard and desires to convert it to permanent supportive housing for seniors. They are working with the State of Washington on a grant that would support this acquisition and conversion. They need to have a local match of 5% which would be provided with the City's \$275,000. A location on Capitol Boulevard provides for excellent transit access, walkability, and access to a range of services. A conversion project allows for housing to be provided and made available much faster than new construction. The Housing Authority will need a formal indication of support and participation from the City.
