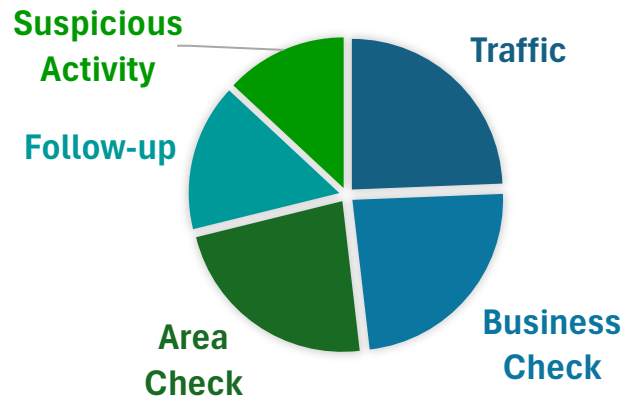

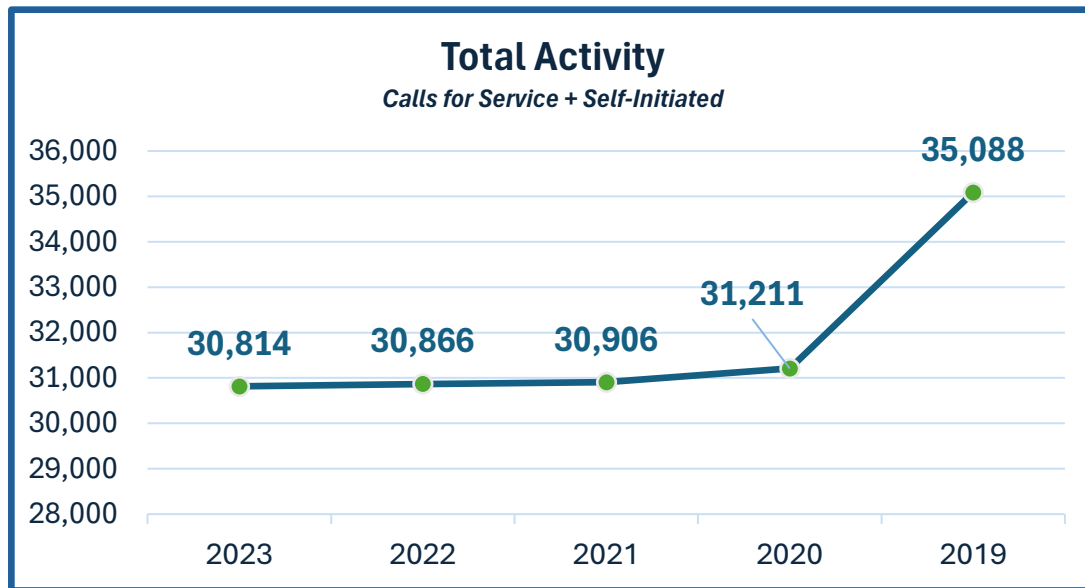
Top 5 Self-Initiated Activities

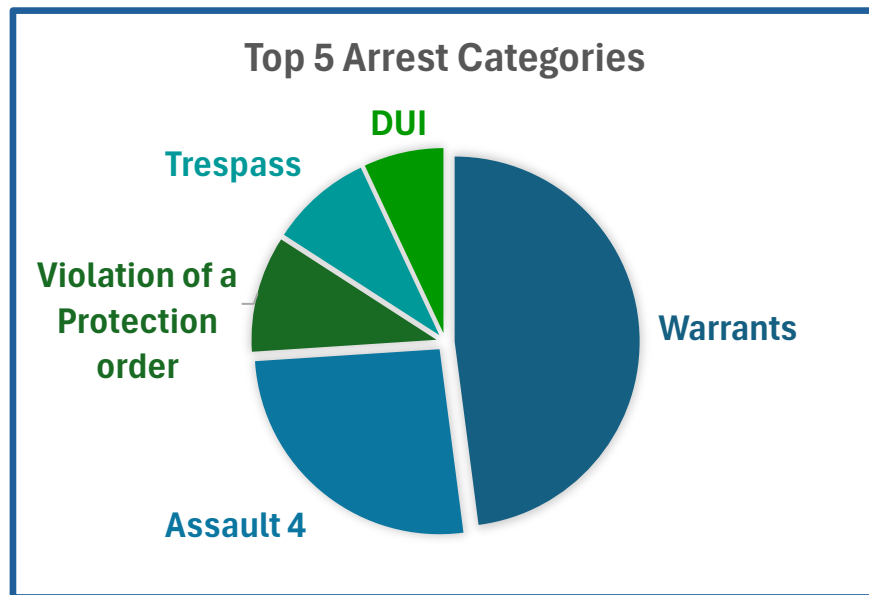
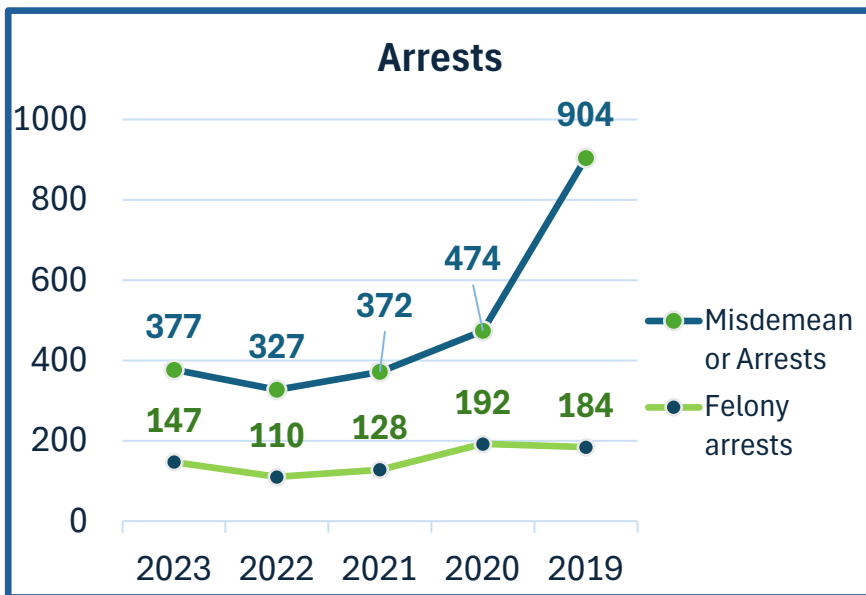

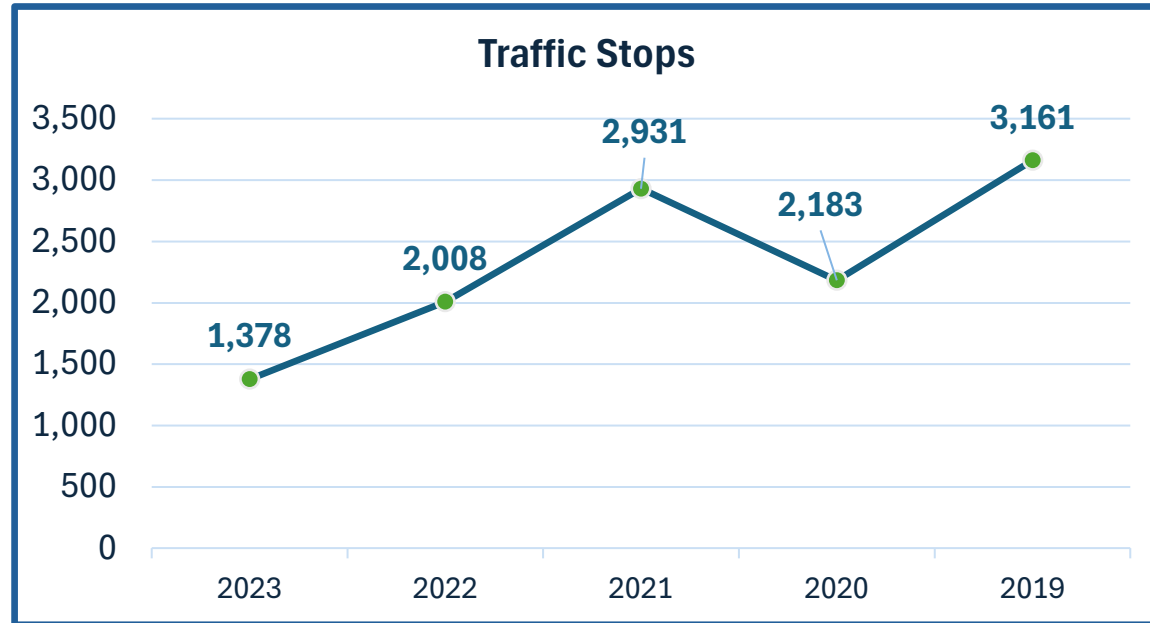

INVESTIGATIONS - NOTABLE CASES

Arson at the Brewmaster House

A subject camping nearby set fire to the historic building because he was upset with another camper.

Self Storage Burglary

Six units in a local self storage business were burgled by a ring of experienced dealers in stolen property.

Embezzlement

A local company discovered fraudulent checks drawn on their business account. Detectives arrested the financial manager for embezzling \$33,724.70 from her employer.

Serial Fraud

A complicated case involving multiple incidents of fraud stretching from Tumwater to the Netherlands to the Seychelles.

Hit & Run/Death Investigation

A driver unknowingly drove over an individual likely lying in the street causing the death of the individual.

Golf Course Burglary

A subject broke into the golf course shop and took multiple items. Detectives used cell phone records to identify the suspect.

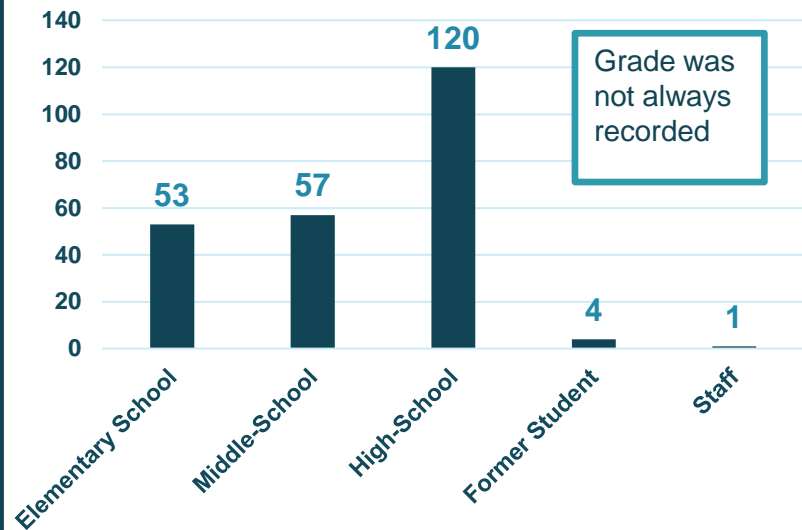

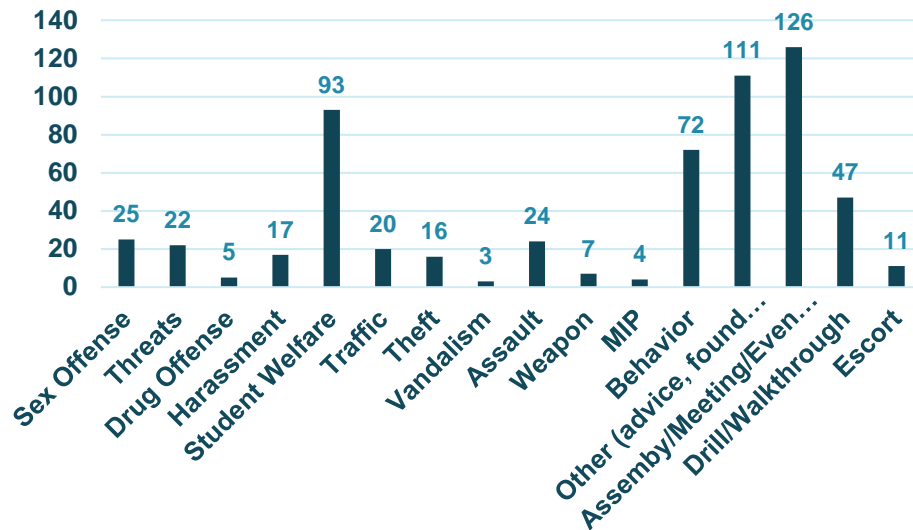


SROS – INCIDENT DATA

Grade of Involved Individuals



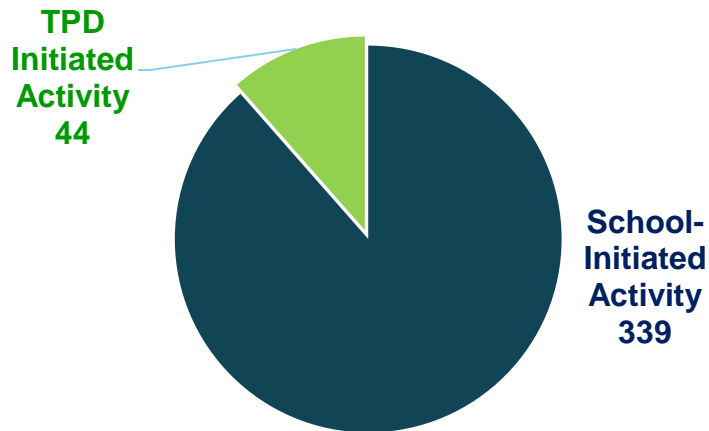
Type of Incident or Event



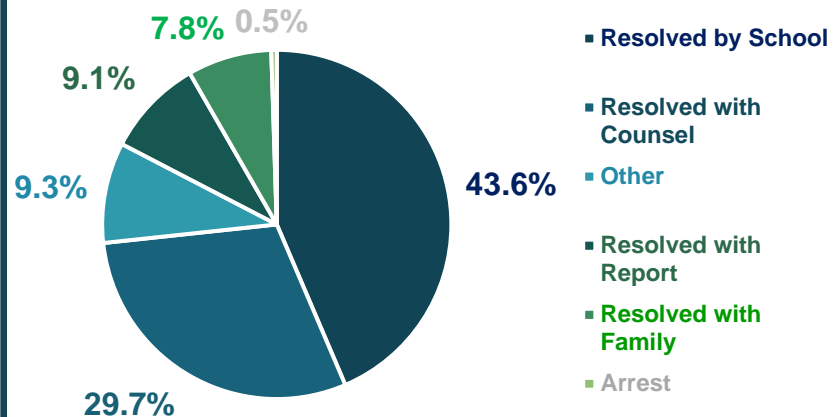

Resolutions of SRO Involved Incidents





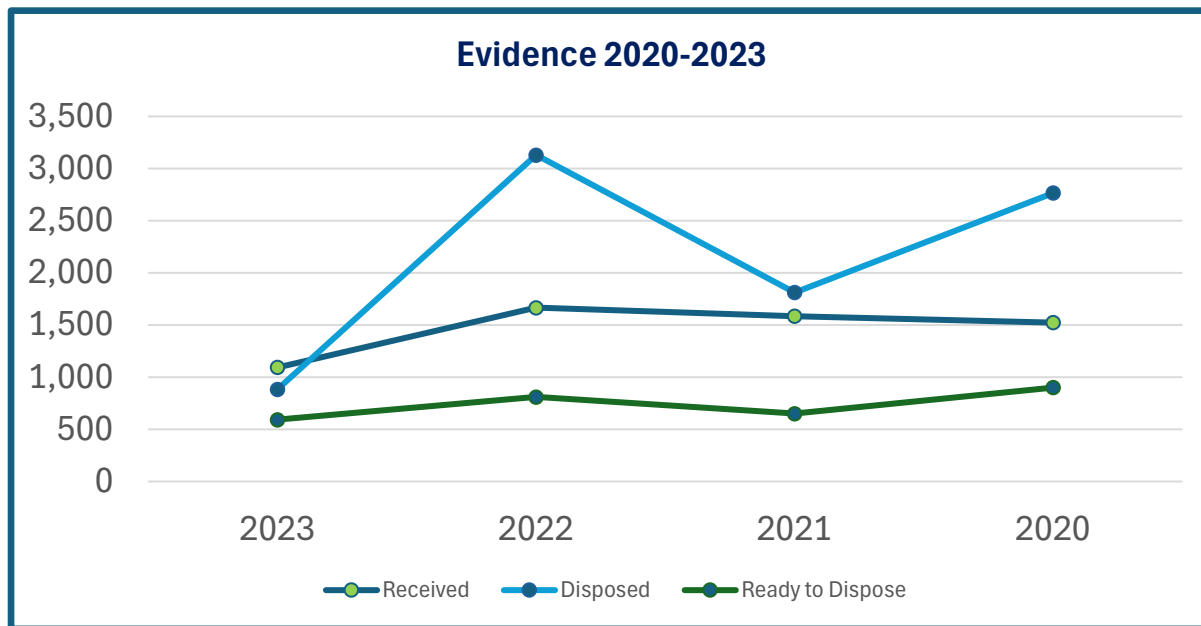

City Incidents/Accidents



Chain link fence damaged
when officer climbed over
chasing suspect.

Police vehicle struck by suspect's vehicle.

Car windows broken
by less-lethal
munitions.

Sergeant unable to remove a
backpack from a suspect and had
to cut the straps.

An officer's patrol vehicle sustained
damage when it struck a deer.

An officer left a suspect's cell phone
on top of the police vehicle and could
not be located when returning to the
station.

A sergeant suffered an arm injury
while multiple officers struggled to
detain someone in mental crisis.

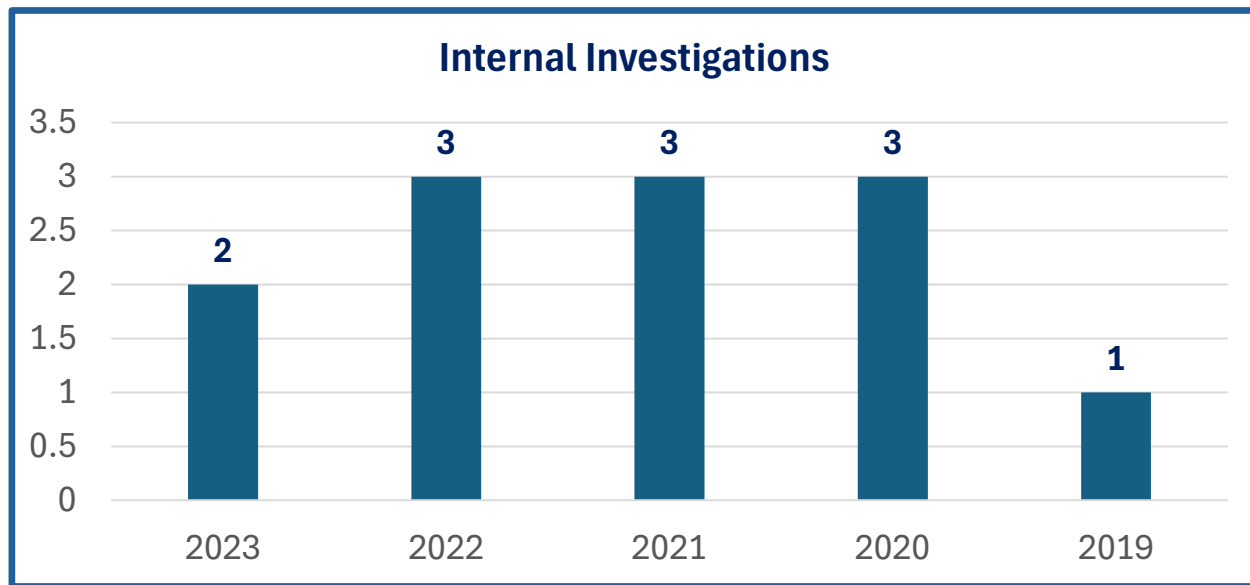

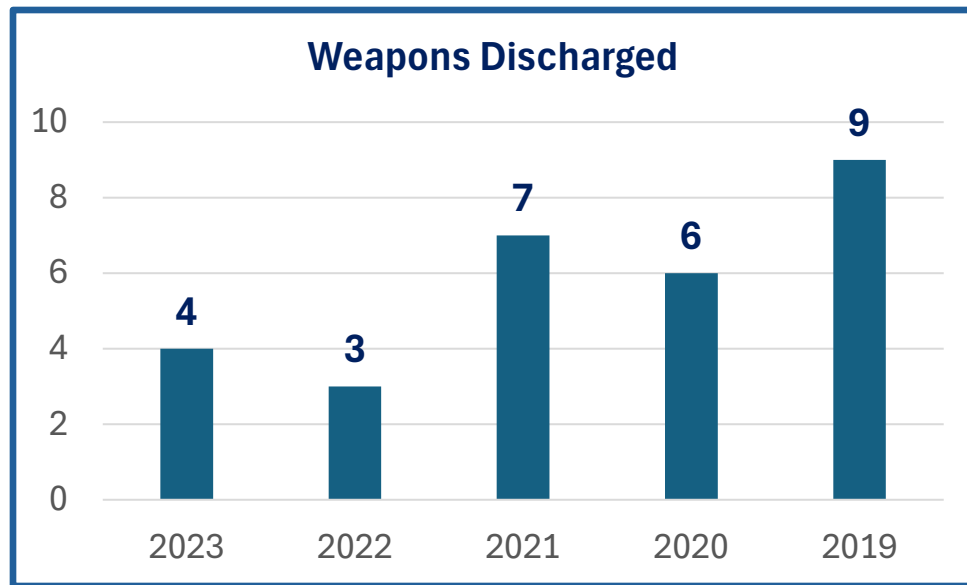
