SUBJECT:	Service Provider Agreement with Stantec for the Pioneer Park Riparian Restoration Amendment 1

1) <u>Recommended Action</u>:

Staff requests City Council approve Amendment 1, which updates required contract provisions for the Department of Ecology, and authorize the Mayor to sign this Amendment with Stantec for the Pioneer Park Riparian Restoration project.

2) <u>Background</u>:

The southwest portion of Pioneer Park's shoreline is rapidly eroding away, washing approximately 2,380 cubic yards of fine sediment every year into the Deschutes River, threatening a critical stock of Coho salmon. The project underway completes designs, acquires permits, and will ultimately construct a riparian restoration project to stabilize the slope and improve habitat conditions along that stretch of the Deschutes River.

The Washington Department of Ecology (ECY) has recently revised its standard contract language provisions for any agreement underwritten by ECY grant or loan funds. The contract being amended herein was executed prior to ECY's requirement for the language inclusion, and ECY has since requested any contract held by the City funded in whole or in part, to be updated with the revised language.

3) Policy Support:

City Council approved the Service Provider Agreement with Stantec for the Pioneer Park Riparian Restoration project on June 29, 2022.

4) <u>Alternatives</u>:
