**Action Requested:** Move to authorize changing job title of Assistant Fire Chief to Deputy Fire Chief

## **Iustification:**

- 2. **Alignment with Duties**: The Assistant Fire Chief is already performing tasks that are more aligned with those of a Deputy Fire Chief, reclassification ensures that the job title accurately reflects the scope of work and responsibilities.
- 3. **Operational Efficiency**: A clearer command structure can improve operational efficiency, streamline decision-making processes, and enhance the department's ability to respond to emergencies and manage resources effectively.
- 4. **Competitive Positioning**: Aligning job titles with industry standards can help the city attract and retain top talent, ensuring that the fire department remains competitive with other jurisdictions.
