## 1) <u>Recommended Action</u>:

Authorization for the Mayor to sign the First Amendment to Nisqually Jail Service Agreement.

## 2) <u>Background</u>:

The 2017-2022 Nisqually Jail Service Agreement expired on January 1, 2022. The First Amendment to Nisqually Jail Service Agreement was drafted to provide both entities time to enter into a new contract by the end of 2022.

## 3) <u>Policy Support</u>:

2021-2022 Strategic Priority: "Provide and Sustain Quality Public Safety Services"

## 4) <u>Alternatives</u>:

We have no other alternative. The Nisqually Jail is the only facility currently allowing suspects to be booked for misdemeanor offenses.

## 5) <u>Fiscal Notes</u>:

The daily contract rate for 2021 was \$71.03 and the 2022 rate is adjusted to \$100.00. The rate increase is due to expanded mental health, medical and other services provided at the facility.
