1) <u>Recommended Action</u>:

Approve and authorize the Mayor to sign the Department of Homeland Security and Federal Emergency Management Agency Public Assistance Grant Agreement for disaster declaration # FEMA-4650-DR-WA for severe winter storms and authorize the Fire Chief, or their designee, to sign documents related to and manage the implementation of the agreement.

2) <u>Background</u>:

On March 29, 2022 a Presidential disaster declaration was declared for facility damage related to severe storms during the January 1-16, 2022 period. Damage may be related to straight-line winds, flooding, landslides and mudslides. The Public Assistance Grant program is made available to provide assistance to communities so they can quickly respond and recover from major disasters or emergencies. The City sustained damages to park trails and facilities related to flooding that is currently under evaluation by FEMA staff.
