

**SECOND AMENDMENT
TO
SERVICE PROVIDER AGREEMENT
FOR
CITY OF TUMWATER CORROSION CONTROL STUDY**

This Second Amendment ("Amendment") is dated effective this 1st day of January, 2024, and is entered into by and between the CITY OF TUMWATER, a Washington municipal corporation ("CITY"), and HDR Engineering, Inc., a Nebraska corporation ("SERVICE PROVIDER").

A. The CITY and the SERVICE PROVIDER entered into a Service Provider Agreement dated effective August 17, 2021, and First Amendment dated January 1, 2023, whereby the SERVICE PROVIDER agreed to provide design and permitting services ("Agreement").

B. Section 14 of the Agreement provided that the Agreement may only be amended by written agreement signed by the parties.

C. The CITY and the SERVICE PROVIDER desire to extend the term of the Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree to the following terms and conditions:

1. TERM.

Section 2 of the Agreement shall be amended to extend the term of the Agreement until December 31, 2024.
