SUBJECT: Third Amendment to Service Provider Agreement for Right of Way Legal Services

1) Recommended Action:

Staff recommends City Council approve and make a motion authorizing the Mayor to sign the Third Amendment to Professional Services Agreement for Right of Way Legal Services – Capitol Blvd / Trosper Rd Improvements Project with Kenyon Disend, PLLC, for a total compensation not to exceed \$150,000.

2) Background:

Kenyon Disend, PLLC has been providing legal services for acquisition of right of way needed for the I-5 / Trosper Rd / Capitol Blvd Reconfiguration project. The original Agreement in 2020 provided for \$50,000 in compensation. The First Amendment increased the contract amount by \$25,000 for a total compensation of \$75,000. The Second Amendment increased the contract amount by \$75,000 for a total compensation not to exceed \$150,000. This Third Amendment increases the hourly rate of compensation, beginning January 1, 2023.

3) Policy Support:

C. Create and maintain a transportation system safe for all modes of travel.

4) <u>Alternatives</u>:

Recommend a different total compensation amount.

Funds for this agreement are provided in the I-5 / Trosper Rd / Capitol Blvd Reconfiguration project, included in the Transportation Capital Facilities Plan budget.
