SUBJECT: Trails End Park Master Planning

1) Recommended Action:

Information Item – The Commission will be reviewing information from the March 29, 2023 public open house and continuing the refinement of the neighborhood park master plan.

2) <u>Background</u>:

The City has contracted with Robert W. Droll, Landscape Architect, (RWD) to design the master plan for a new neighborhood park at the site of the former Trails End horse facility. This process will involve participation of the Parks and Recreation Commission and the public.

The first planning and design meeting was held in May of 2022. On March 29, 2023, local residents were invited to the second park planning meeting.
