

RESOLUTION NO. R2026-002

A RESOLUTION of the City Council of the City of Tumwater, Washington adopting the 2025 Thurston County Hazardous Waste Management Plan.

WHEREAS, Thurston County is required to prepare a Hazardous Waste Management Plan (Plan) pursuant to RCW 70A.300.350; and

WHEREAS, incorporated cities and towns in Thurston County have participated with the County in developing the Plan for hazardous waste management pursuant to an Interlocal Agreement between the City of Tumwater and Thurston County for the Thurston County Solid Waste Management Plan and the Hazardous Waste Plan Updates executed by the City October 16, 2012; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Plan to be updated pursuant to RCW 70A.300.350; and

WHEREAS, the Thurston County Solid Waste Advisory Committee recommended approval of the Plan on June 5, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Plan has been reviewed as a non-project action under SEPA and a Determination of Nonsignificance was issued on May 15, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the adopted Plan will be submitted to the Washington State Department of Ecology for final approval; and

WHEREAS, adoption of the Plan is in the best interest of, and supports the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Tumwater;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TUMWATER AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Adoption. The 2025 Thurston County Hazardous Waste Management Plan attached hereto as Exhibit A is hereby adopted as the City of Tumwater hazardous waste management plan.

Section 2. Implementation. Thurston County is authorized to administer and implement the hazardous waste management plan within the City of Tumwater consistent with the Plan.

Section 3. Ratification. Any act consistent with the authority and prior to the effective date of this Resolution is hereby ratified and affirmed.

Section 4. Severability. The provisions of this Resolution are declared separate and severable. The invalidity of any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section, or portion of this Resolution or the invalidity of the application thereof to any person or circumstance, shall not affect the validity of the remainder of the Resolution, or the validity of its application to other persons or circumstances.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption and signature as provided by law.
