ORDINANCE AMENDING DEVELOPMENT CODE CHAPTERS 4 - BASE ZONING DISTRICTS AND TABLE 5.3.4 BY ADDING PROVISIONS REQUIRING MINIMUM DISTANCES BETWEEN "CONVENIENCE STORES WITH FUEL SALES" AND ALSO REQUIRING "CONVENIENCE STORES WITH FUEL SALES" BE LOCATED ON ARTERIAL ROADS

SUMMARY

This ordinance amends City of Tupelo Development Code Chapter 4 - Base Zoning Districts and Table 5.3.4 by requiring minimum distances between convenience stores with fuel sales and requiring convenience stores with fuel sales to be located on an arterial road. The minimum distance between any convenience store with fuel sales and another convenience store with fuel sales shall be One Thousand Five Hundred (1,500) feet. This distance shall be measured from lot line to lot line. This distance shall be measured in a straight line, such as air line distance, rather than the usual route of pedestrian travel. All convenience stores with fuel sales shall also be located on an arterial road as defined in Development Code 6.8.4.1, or by compatibility if standard is not met.

The effective date of this Ordinance shall be November 7, 2025

SUMMARY

This ordinance amends City of Tupelo Code of Ordinance Chapter 26, Utilities - Article II - Sewage and Sewage Disposal, by adding Article VIII - Grease Ordinance and Inspection. This addition creates a grease inspection program to better effectuate the city's powers under Article II - Sewage and Sewage Disposal, Sec. 26-91. The ordinance outlines the applicability and prohibitions under the ordinance; provides definitions; establishes requirements in new and existing buildings; provides requirements for cleaning and maintenance; allows self-cleaning only by special permit; requires cleaning schedules; requires manifests of disposal, provides for alternate treatments and establishes a schedule of penalties for violations.

The effective date of this Ordinance shall be November 21, 2025.
