ORDINANCE AMENDING DEVELOPMENT CODE CHAPTER 2 DEFINITIONS TO INCLUDE BREWERIES, MICROBREWERIES, BREWPUBS, WINERIES, NATIVE WINERIES, DISTILLERIES AND NATIVE DISTILLERIES SIGNS (BILLBOARDS)
(1A25-02.3)

Pursuant to the Miss. Code Anno. §21-17-9, in lieu of the full text being printed, the following explanatory statement summarizes the substance of the ordinance. A copy of the full text of the ordinance has been posted (a) on the first floor of City Hall at 71 East Troy Street, Tupelo, Mississippi 38804, (b) the first floor of the Lee County Justice Center at 200 West Jefferson Street, Tupelo, MS 38804, (c) Lee County Library at 219 N. Madison Street, Tupelo, MS 38804. Any resident may request a copy of the full text of the ordinance from City Clerk Kim Hanna on the 2nd floor of City Hall at 71 East Troy St., Tupelo, MS 38804.

SUMMARY

The ordinance amendments provide definitions for the following uses: BREWERY; BREWERY, SMALL CRAFT; BREWPUB; DISTILLERY; MICROBREWERY; NATIVE MEADERY; NATIVE DISTILLERY; NATIVE WINERY; WINERY. Base zoning and overlay districts will be designated by separate ordinance.

The effective date of this Ordinance shall be February 6, 2026.
