

ORDER

AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY TO THE CITY OF TUPELO

WHEREAS, the governing authorities of the City of Tupelo are empowered to act with respect to the care, management and control of municipal affairs and its properties for which no provision has been made by general law and which is not inconsistent with existing law pursuant to Section 21-17-1, et seq. of the Mississippi Code Annotated (1972), as amended, including the authority to sell, convey or lease real property on such terms as it may elect that are consistent with statutory authority; and

WHEREAS, in compliance with the provision of Miss. Code Anno. Sec. 43-37-3 (1972 as amended) governing acquisition of real property using public funds, the City of Tupelo has negotiated a contract for the purchase of a property for the negotiated price of One Thousand Dollars, (\$1,000.00) for the right-of-way property having located on Reese Street, Tupelo, Mississippi and at Parcel No. 088J-33-054-01; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tupelo desires to purchase the existing property for incorporation into Veteran’s Park.

WHEREAS, the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into the Contract of Purchase attached hereto as Exhibit “A”.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved and ordered by the City Council of Tupelo as follows:

1. The prefatory paragraphs of this Resolution are hereby found and determined to be in accordance with the necessary and warranted exercise of the authority of the City of Tupelo by securing necessary interests in the real property for the purpose of incorporation into Veteran’s Park.
2. The Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the purchase contract and purchase from **MARY YVETTE WHITE LOURIE**, the right-of-way of the real property located on Reese Street as more particularly described in the attached Contract for Purchase for the amount of One Thousand Dollars and No Cents, (\$1,000.00), plus the costs of closing.
