Approval of Minutes

Budget Report

Kim Hannah reviewed the Major Thoroughfare Phase VII Budget Report for the month ending January 31, 2025. Beginning Cash Balance was \$5,868,041. Total Revenue from Property Tax was \$1,728,990, Interest Earned was \$20,104. Total Revenue was \$1,749,094. Total Expenditures for January were \$279,522. Payments included \$9,780 for Personnel Cost, \$269,608 for West Jackson (Madison to Front), and \$133 (Barnes Crossing to Gloster New Road. Ending Cash Balance for is \$7,337,613.

Current Projects

Dennis Bonds reviewed updates on the current projects

- Jackson Street (Madison to Front)
 - O Underground Utility work is ongoing and going well.
 - O Roadwork has been awarded and contract approved.
 - O Expect to start late March/ Early April.
- New Road (Gloster to Northern Loop)
 - O Design work is ongoing. Development is still on track.
- 2025 MTC Mill & Overlay Bids for this work will be opened March/ April timeframe.
