ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 19, ARTICLE VI. - REGULATIONS FOR

DISPLAY FOR SALE OF MOTOR VEHICLES, MOTORIZED EQUIPMENT,

BOATS, TRAILERS, RECREATIONAL VEHICLES AND CAMPERS

## **Request:**

On October 1, 2013, the City of Tupelo adopted the Development Code of the City of Tupelo, Mississippi, which--among other matters--provided that no business involving the sale, repair, restoration, refinishing, or painting of vehicles, farm equipment, boats, small engines, or recreational vehicles may be approved as a home business.

The Development Code should have superseded provisions in conflict with it contained in the general Code of Ordinances of the City of Tupelo, Mississippi. The general Code of Ordinances contained provisions addressing the subject matter above in Chapter 19, Article VI - Regulations for Display for Sale of Motor Vehicles, Motorized Equipment, Boats, Trailers, Recreational Vehicles and Campers. Sections of Chapter 19, Article VI were last amended on May 4, 2010. Provisions of Chapter 19, Article VI stand in direct conflict with provisions of the subsequent Development Code and are in need of amendment or repeal to conform the Code of Ordinances with the Development Code.
