BREWPUB: A restaurant with a small brewery on the premises which produces beer, ale, or other malt beverage, and where the majority of the beer produced is consumed on the premises. This classification allows a brewpub to sell beer at retail and/or act as wholesaler for beer of its own production for off-site consumption, with appropriate State licenses.

MEADERY: An establishment primarily engaged in the production and distribution of mead, and which may include accessory uses such as tours of the production facility, retail sales, and/or on-site consumption, e.g., 'taproom.' This classification allows a Meadery to sell mead at retail and/or act as wholesaler for mead of its own production for off-site consumption with appropriate State licenses.

MICROBREWERY: An establishment primarily engaged in the distribution of beer, ale, or other malt beverages, and which may include accessory uses such as tours of the microbrewery, retail sales, and/or on-site consumption, e.g., 'taproom.' This classification allows a microbrewery to sell beer at retail and/or act as wholesaler for beer of its own production for off-site consumption with appropriate State licenses.

LIQUOR STORE/PACKAGE STORE: An establishment owned and/or operated by a person issued a permit by the Mississippi Department of Revenue—Alcohol Beverage Control authorizing the holder thereof to operate a store exclusively for the sale at retail in original sealed and unopened packages of alcoholic beverages, including native wines, not to be consumed on the premises where sold, pursuant to MCA 1972, § 67-1-51(1)(b).
