WHEREAS, on the 22nd day of August, 2025, the Department of Revenue of the State of Mississippi approved the application, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, a certified copy of the aforesaid Department of Revenue's approval has been received by the Council and recorded in its minutes.

WHEREAS, the Department of Revenue requires this Resolution be on its form, and same is attached hereto as Exhibit "B".

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises, the City Council of Tupelo,

Mississippi does hereby finally approve the application for ad valorem tax exemption, except

State and School District ad valorem taxes for a period of ten (10) years beginning on the 1st day

of January, 2025 and ending the 31st day of December, 2034, with a total true value of \$660,000.00.
