**RESOLUTION OF CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TUPELO, MISSISSIPPI,
AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION FOR MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT
OF TRANSPORTATION (MDOT) EMERGENCY ROAD AND BRIDGE REPAIR FUND
(ERBRF)**

WHEREAS, the Mississippi Department of Transportation (MDOT) is soliciting projects for the Emergency Road and Bridge Repair Fund (ERBRF) Program for emergency repairs to public roads and bridges in the state, and

WHEREAS, City of Tupelo, Mississippi, desires to submit an application for [*insert identified eligible project descriptions*]; and
