- 3. Pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. §21-19-11 (1972) as amended, City of Tupelo may charge Owner with the actual cost of demolition, including administrative and legal costs of the municipality, and may also impose a penalty of one-half of the actual cost or \$1500.00, whichever is more.
- 4. The City of Tupelo, by and through its council, at a regularly scheduled meeting held on 07/05/2022, adjudicated the actual cost of demolition to be \$3900.00. The City of Tupelo, by and through its council, for a total assessment against the property of \$3900.00. This amount is assessed as a lien on the real property.
